garja garja - from Devi-māhātmyam

The Devi said: 'Roar, roar, O fool, for a moment while I drink this wine. When you will be slain by me, the devas will soon roar in this very place.'

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garja garja – roar, roar (imperative 2<sup>nd</sup> person singular: you (must) roar) kṣaṇaṁ – a moment muḍha – oh fool madhu – this sweetness, wine yāvat - (yāvat – while, as long as) pibāmi – I drink aham - I mayā – by me (first person pronoun, instrumental singular) tvayi - in this (very place), here hate – be slain atra – here eva – just, only garjiṣyanti - they all will roar (futuretense 3<sup>rd</sup> person plural) āśuḥ soon, quickly devatāḥ – all the Goddesses
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
